Vacation Pass: Creating Art in a Sustainable Way

Workshops on sustainability for children - extracurricular educational project with topics on environmental education and sustainable lifestyle

Children from eight to 12 years and with the vacation pass of the city of Dresden are invited by the team of the OSTRALE to create art themselves during the summer break. In Dresden-Übigau, where the "OSTRALE.Basis" of the eponymous center for contemporary art is located, the first week of the vacation pass program has already ended successfully. Starting today (Tuesday of the second vacation week, 26.7.) it continues. Until Saturday (July 30), children can also participate by the day in the vacation week "Sound Sculpture". The children will be guided by Rüdiger Wenk alias "Phonoschrank". The OSTRALE team has also planned further workshops for the fourth and fifth vacation weeks.

The workshop "Sound Sculpture" takes place from Tuesday to Saturday. On the premises of the OSTRALE.Basis (Rethelstraße 45, 01139 Dresden-Übigau) children can create a sound sculpture together. It is to be made from natural materials that can be found in Dresden. The goal is to create a musical instrument as a noisemaker and experimental object that will continue to function after the summer break. Participation is free of charge, and snacks will be provided. Short-notice registrations are still possible.

July 26-30, 2022 (2nd vacation week, Tue - Fri: 9:30 a.m. - 1:30 p.m., Sat: 10 a.m. - 2 p.m.)

Sound Sculpture with Rüdiger Wenk (Phonoschrank)

We will unlock mysterious sounds from natural materials and create a sculpture.

Open workshop - participation in this week also possible by the day.

August 09-13, 2022 (4th vacation week, Tue - Fri: 9.30am - 1.30pm, Sat: 10am - 2pm).

Stone sculpting with Simone Schulz

We will create sandstone sculptures for the art garden using special tools.

Bring along: Those who have are welcome to bring their own sculpting tools.

August 16-20, 2022 (5th vacation week, Tue - Fri: 9:30 a.m. - 1:30 p.m., Sat: 10 a.m. - 2 p.m.)

Paper making from nature with Johanna Schründer

We'll conjure up sustainable things from collected leaves, grasses, flowers and scrap paper.

Bring along: Those who wish are welcome to bring scraps of fabric, waste paper and for dyeing, for example, turmeric, dandelion, tea or coffee grounds.

The workshops always count as a whole continuous week, as the individual days build on each other. The project is funded within the framework Rahmen „Profil: Soziokultur - Sonderprogramm NEUSTART KULTUR“. If there are still places available, children can also take part without a vacation pass. About the Vacation Pass:

The Vacation Pass is valid for Dresden children from 6 to 14 years in the period from July 16 to August 28, 2022 and costs 10 euros. From June 13, it will be available in the citizens' offices, in the municipal ticket offices Ostra-Allee 9, Theaterstraße 11 and Junghansstraße 2 as well as in the administrative offices Cossebaude, Weixdorf and Langebrück. It can be purchased there without pre-registration. Contacts and information are available at www.dresden.de/buergerbueros. Cashless payment is applicable for the most part. Children with a valid Dresden Pass receive a free copy.

In addition, the Youth Welfare Office offers sales appointments at its premises, Enderstraße 59: on Tuesday, June 28, on Thursday, July 7, and on Tuesday, July 12, in each case from 2 to 5 pm. Here, pick-up appointments must be made in advance by calling 0351-4884665. Payment at the Youth Welfare Office is only possible with cash.
